A BILL TO: Create a Textbook Exchange to Ease the Cost of Education for Students.

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

WHEREAS, The price of a college education has been increasing substantially every year; and

WHEREAS, One source of high expense is the price of textbooks, which are exorbitant; and

WHEREAS, The use of older textbooks should not have a significant impact on the quality of education received from using such books; and

WHEREAS, The Business Office has estimated the provisions of this act would necessitate some substantial start-up cost; therefore be it

RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University shall establish a "Textbook Exchange," to which students will be able to donate textbooks at the end of each semester, to allow others to rent those books free of cost during subsequent semesters. Furthermore, be it

RESOLVED, A sum of \$500 shall be appropriated from the general fund to cover the costs of labor and of administrative work necessary to create and oversee the exchange.




