A BILL TO: Call for the Amendment or Deletion of Criminal History Question on Admission Applications

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

WHEREAS, The Michigan State University Undergraduate admittance application requires applicants to disclose prior criminal history while assuring that past criminal history “rarely results in the denial of admission”; and,

WHEREAS, This question has been statistically proven to discourage applicants with criminal history to complete the application; and,

WHEREAS, It has not been statistically proven that criminal history screening improves campus safety; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University, while recognizing Michigan State University’s right to ensure campus safety, requests that this question be amended or deleted; furthermore, be it

RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University gives the Vice-President of Academic Affairs and the Vice-President of Governmental Affairs the authority to lobby within their respective fields for the aforementioned request.


