**A BILL TO: Allocate \$50,000 from Special Projects to fund a Spartan Celebration**

WHEREAS, The Michigan State University Spartan Football team won the 100<sup>th</sup> Rose Bowl January 1, 2014; and,

WHEREAS, There is currently an enthusiastic atmosphere across campus bringing both MSU students and the community together; and,

WHEREAS, ASMSU would like to continue the enthusiasm by presenting a Spartan Celebration, alongside MSU Athletics, and other major departments; and,

WHEREAS, ASMSU is also in the process of launching a “What Would Sparty Do?” campaign promoting positive sportsman like behavior; therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That up to \$50,000 be allocated from Special Projects to fund a Spartan Celebration, to engage Michigan State University students and the MSU Community encouraging positive celebrations; therefore be it further,

RESOLVED, Should admission be charged, all revenue generated from tickets will be returned to Special Projects; therefore be it further,

RESOLVED, All contract approvals and expenditures of funds will comply with all ASMSU and Michigan State University procedures; therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the ASMSU Central Staff, with the advice and consent of the ASMSU Interim President, shall be responsible for planning the event.
