A BILL TO: Advocate for the investigation of alternative sections of MTH 201 and 202, that will better prepare future educators for their careers as teachers

WHEREAS, MTH 201 and 202 are required math classes that teach the proofs behind the mathematical concepts of high-school level material; and,

WHEREAS, These courses are intended to help prepare elementary education students to be teachers in elementary classrooms; and

WHEREAS, The material in these courses should be more relevant to elementary education, and facilitate the understanding of elementary-level mathematical concepts; and

WHEREAS, Education majors will be in classrooms after they graduate, and should be best prepared to teach their students; therefore be it,

RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University will advocate for the investigation into alternative sections of MTH 201 and 202 that will teach relevant material for future elementary educations, in order to have an equal chance to succeed in the next step of their lives.
