A BILL TO: Advocate for a university policy to allow students to retake any class for any reason

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

- WHEREAS, The current university policy only allows course retakes in the event of a course grade below 2.0; and
- WHEREAS, Undergraduate students attend Michigan State University in order to prepare themselves for the next step in their lives, which includes mastering particular subject areas; and,
- WHEREAS, Students should have the right to take a course as many times as they would like as they are paying for their education; and,
- WHEREAS, It is a fundamental right for students to be able to choose their education path; therefore be it,
- RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University will advocate for a new policy to allow students to retake any course they would like to, regardless of their prior performance in a class, in order to give every student an equal chance to succeed in the next step of their lives.
