WHEREAS, Many students live in off-campus apartment complexes with no recycling pickup; and

WHEREAS, Residents in these multi-family complexes must choose between accumulating recyclable material in an already limited space before bringing the material to a drop off location or discarding these recyclable materials in dumpsters to be sent to a landfill; and,

WHEREAS, Many students travel by bus or bicycle and do not own cars, which makes it more difficult to bring recyclable materials to a drop off facility; and,

WHEREAS, There is wide student interest in a recycling service for these multi-family complexes; therefore be it,



