A RESOLUTION TO: Endorse the creation of an Academic Advising Committee

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

- WHEREAS, Standards for academic advising currently exist to address the quality and consistency of advising that should be given, and advising at Michigan State University is not consistent with these standards; and,
- WHEREAS, There is no established process for assessing the quality of academic advisers, and advisers are not currently mandated to attend professional development, attend available trainings, or reference training manuals; and,
- WHEREAS, Students look to academic advisers for guidance on what courses to take to maximize their individual experience at the university and graduate in a timely manner; and,
- WHEREAS, The implementation of standards as well as the standards themselves should be analyzed by the university administration to determine actions to maximize the effectiveness of student advising; therefore be it,
- RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University endorse the establishment of an Academic Advising Committee by Michigan State University to improve academic advising standards and examine the processes to develop a more holistic student advising approach; and therefore be it further,
- RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University further advocate that students be appointed to the Academic Advising Committee to serve as a voice for their peers.
