**A BILL TO: Allocate Funding Toward the General Promotion and Campus-wide Implementation of the "Spartan Code of Honor: Academic Pledge"**

**THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:**

WHEREAS, The Spartan Code of Honor: Academic Pledge is the outcome of a student-led initiative to promote personal and scholastic integrity at Michigan State University; and,

WHEREAS, The work of the Spartan Code of Honor is the beginning of a larger educational campaign designed by ASMSU to re-define a personal commitment to ethical behavior in a student's studies and research; and,

WHEREAS, ASMSU has adopted the pledge and the University Council has endorsed the work of the project in March of 2016, and the MSU Board of Trustees will similarly recognize and endorse the importance and work of the project in April of 2016; and,

WHEREAS, All undergraduate Spartans will be expected to uphold the academic pledge upon enrollment of classes at Michigan State University; and,

WHEREAS, the Academic Pledge might follow in the lifetime of a graduate from Michigan State University, establishing a greater societal recognition for the values of honest and ethical work behind a degree attained at Michigan State University; and,

WHEREAS, The Spartan Code of Honor: Academic Pledge will be anchored in the "Spartan Life Handbook" for easy reference by students, professors, and all other members of the MSU learning community; and,

WHEREAS, It is imperative that the Associated Students of Michigan State University works with the campus community to install signage and distribute promotional materials toward the campaign as soon as possible; therefore be it,

RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University allocates \$15,000 toward the general promotion and campus-wide implementation of the *Spartan Code of Honor: Academic Pledge* educational campaign.


