**A BILL TO: Amend the Class Council Code of Operations**

**THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:**

WHEREAS, According to ASMSU's Code of Operations, Title Five Section 2 states, "Membership of the Sophomore, Junior, and Senior Class Councils shall be selected in a manner consistent with the ASMSU Spring Elections;" and,

WHEREAS, Title Five Section 3 states that, "Membership of the Freshman Class Council shall be selected by the Vice President for Internal Administration through an application process in consultation with the General Assembly" and,

WHEREAS, Class council elections have not attracted a sufficient number of candidates in recent elections, and the process of selecting council members through an application process administered by the Vice President for Internal Administration has proven to be more efficient; and,

WHEREAS, The proposed change to Title 5 Section 2 would read as followed, "Membership of the Class Councils shall be selected by the Vice President for Internal Administration and Liaison of Diversity and Inclusion Initiatives (or designate) through an application process in consultation with the General Assembly;" therefore, be it;

RESOLVED, That the General Assembly approves and amends Title 5 Section 2 to read as followed, "Membership of the Class Councils shall be selected by the Vice President for Internal Administration and Liaison of Diversity and Inclusion Initiatives (or designate) through an application process;" therefore, be it further,

RESOLVED, That the General Assembly approves the removal of Title 5 Section 3.
