East Lansing City Council Proposal #1

Currently, the City of East Lansing Charter establishes that City Council member terms of office begin the Tuesday following that City election.

The City Council is proposing that Charter Section 3.3 be amended to change the commencement date of City Council member terms of office to the first Tuesday following January 1 of the following calendar year, and shall be effective beginning at the next regular City election.

Shall the amendment as proposed be adopted?

East Lansing City Council Proposal #2

Currently, the City of East Lansing Charter establishes that the City Council be composed of five (5) members.

The City Council is proposing that Charter Chapters 3 and 4 be amended to change the composition of the City Council to seven (7) members, of which the additional members shall be elected at the next regular City election as established by Charter.

Shall the amendment as proposed be adopted?
