#### THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

WHEREAS, The Associated Students of Michigan State University (ASMSU) was founded to "ensure the protection and defense of the rights of students, provide comprehensive and valuable services to the student body, [and] promote the health and wellness of undergraduate Spartans"; and,

WHEREAS, There exist many establishments at MSU that exist to support marginalized students such as the Gender and Sexuality Campus Center (GSCC); and,

**WHEREAS**, The GSCC's mission is to celebrate, affirm, and support Queer and Trans individuals and communities at Michigan State University<sup>2</sup>; and,

WHEREAS, One of the best ways to support these establishments and the work they do is by providing financial support. This allows the GSCC to increase funding for existing programming, offer new programming, and better fulfill their mission of supporting LGBTQ+ students; and,

**WHEREAS**, The GSCC relies solely on donor and grant funds, which means money for programming and events are used up quickly each academic year; and,
