**A BILL TO: Reallocate \$2,300 from the ASMSU General Fund to the Class  
Councils Budget to Support their End-of-Year Events**

**THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:**

**WHEREAS,** ASMSU has a Class Council dedicated to each class standing that hosts events to foster a positive environment for undergraduate students at MSU; and,

**WHEREAS,** Junior Class Council hosts an annual event at PinBall Petes to promote and increase voter engagement during the week of General Assembly Spring Elections ; and,

**WHEREAS,** This year the event will be hosted on Thursday, April 3, 2025 from 7-9 pm. The entirety of PinBall Petes will be rented by JCC, and voters will have free access to all games. Food will also be provided; and,

**WHEREAS,** Renting the event space for two hours cost roughly \$1,600 alone, without any food costs included; and,

**WHEREAS,** At the end of each academic year, the ASMSU Senior Class Council plans, organizes, and largely sponsors the Senior and Faculty Awards Banquet to honor the achievements of outstanding seniors and MSU faculty and staff; and,

**WHEREAS,** This year, the Senior Class Council will be hosting this event on Tuesday, April 8th at the Broad Art Museum; and,

**WHEREAS,** The cost for using the Broad Art Museum space is \$1,700 not including catering and any other materials, such as physical awards, that are necessary to ensure a memorable and successful celebration for graduating seniors; and,

**RESOLVED**, That the Associated Students of Michigan State University shall allocate \$2,300 from the ASMSU General Fund to support the ASMSU Class Councils budget to monetarily support their end-of-year events.


