A BILL TO: Allocate \$7,500 to Women\*s Student Services and Gender and Sexuality Campus Center for Opill, an over-the-counter birth control pill

#### THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

WHEREAS, Women's Student Services and Gender and Sexuality Campus Center provide critical services and resources to students, including but not limited to emergency contraception, pregnancy tests, and safer sex products; and,

**WHEREAS,** Opill, the first FDA-approved over-the-counter birth control pill, offers a highly effective, estrogen-free, and safer contraceptive option for the majority of users, with a 98% efficacy rate<sup>1</sup> when used correctly; and,

WHEREAS, Many students face financial barriers in accessing birth control, with Opill costing approximately \$50 every three months<sup>2</sup>, which can be expensive or prohibitive for those without sufficient health insurance coverage or those concerned about confidentiality while on their parents' insurance; and,

WHEREAS, Women's Student Services and Gender and Sexuality Campus Center, through their commitment to promoting reproductive health and education on campus, are well-positioned to ensure the equitable distribution of Opill to the student body; therefore, be it,

**RESOLVED**, That the Associated Students of Michigan State University shall allocate \$7,500 from the General Fund (RY100000) to Women\*s Student Services and the Gender and Sexuality
