**A BILL TO:** Support and Advocate for the Passage of the Stop Campus Hazing Act (S.2901)

**THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:**

**WHEREAS,** The Stop Campus Hazing Act (S.2901) is a bill that would require institutions of higher education to report hazing incidents on their campuses<sup>1</sup>; and,

**WHEREAS,** The bill would also require institutions of higher education to develop comprehensive plans centered around stopping hazing including information about hazing awareness and prevention; and,

**WHEREAS,** Hazing incidents on campuses can detrimentally affect the health and wellbeing of students, and even cause severe injuries and death<sup>2</sup>; and

**WHEREAS,** ASMSU has supported initiatives to allow for this bill to be passed including advocating for it during the Association of Big Ten Students (ABTS) Big Ten on the Hill Conference and through the passage of Bill 60-43<sup>3</sup>, which added ASMSU's signature to a letter urging for the passing of the bill; therefore be it,

**RESOLVED,** That the Associated Students of Michigan State University shall advocate for and support the passage of the Stop Campus Hazing Act (S.2901); therefore be it further,


