A BILL TO: Allow the Student Allocations Board to Conduct Business While Not Operating Under a Quorum Again

## THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

WHEREAS, Per Title II, Section 5 of the Student Allocations Board Code of Operations, "The voting membership of the Student Allocations Board shall consist of never less than twelve (12) and never more than twenty-one (21) members,"<sup>1</sup>; and,

**WHEREAS,** At the moment, the Student Allocations Board is currently not at quorum, as 12 members have not been able to be recruited; and,

WHEREAS, This has caused backups in regard to funding requests from both RSOs and CORES&COPS organizations; and,

WHEREAS, Per Title II, Section 5, Subsection E of the Student Allocations Board Code of Operations, "The Student Allocations Board shall not conduct official business with less than twelve total appointed members without the express consent of the General Assembly."<sup>2</sup>; and,

WHEREAS, Allowing the Student Allocations Board to run while under a quorum, would allow for RSOs and CORES & COPS organizations to receive funding, while continuing recruitment efforts to the board; therefore be it,

**RESOLVED**, That the Associated Students of Michigan State University's General Assembly shall allow the Student Allocations Board to conduct official business while not operating under a quorum until quorum is reached; therefore be it further,
