A BILL TO: Advocate for More Transparent Nutritional Information within Dining Halls

WHEREAS, Currently, the nutritional information regarding food provided within MSU dining halls is obscure and hard to locate for students; and,

WHEREAS, In order to find the information, a student would have to go to the MSU dining halls website, find the specific dining hall they are in, and then are able to find the nutritional information; and,

WHEREAS, The website for nutritional information is extremely hard to navigate and find the information one needs, as well as the website can be not secured for certain devices; and,

WHEREAS, This can create an unnecessary burden for students who are trying to find the nutritional information for their meals; and,

WHEREAS, Studies have shown that students are prone to weight-gain for a variety of reasons, one being a lack of nutritional options that students might not be aware of therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the Associated Students of Michigan State University shall advocate to relevant parties to create a more accessible and transparent resource for nutritional information; therefore be it further,
