A BILL TO: Advocate for the Construction of a First-Generation Student Center to Begin During the 2025-2026 School Year.

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

WHEREAS, On November 8th, 1965, the Higher Education Act was signed by former President Johnson allowing for federal aid programs to help those pursuing a secondary education¹; and,

WHEREAS, November 8th is recognized as National First-Generation College Celebration Day²; and,

WHEREAS, As of 2022, about 20% of Michigan State University's undergraduate students identify as First-generation³; and,

WHEREAS, President Guskiewicz in his September 29th, 2024 investiture address states "I am excited to introduce the First Gen Center, a new initiative focused on supporting first-generation college students. The center will aggregate a variety of supporting programs, including our bridge-to-college programs, ensuring that first-generation students have the resources and guidance they need to thrive at Michigan State." and,
