**A BILL TO: Advocate to Michigan State University for a \$15 Minimum Wage for
ULA Positions**

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

WHEREAS, Undergraduate Learning Assistant (ULA) is a term referring to any undergraduate student who assists the faculty-of-record in that instructor's assigned, for-credit course(s) at MSU; and,¹

WHEREAS, On campus, Undergraduate Learning Assistants are core members of the teaching team; and,

WHEREAS, In order to stay competitive with on- and off-campus jobs, the hourly wage of ULAs must be raised; and,

WHEREAS, It is important to provide on-campus employees and contractees, including ULAs, with a living wage that can provide for their basic needs, especially with inflation having increased by 2.6% since the beginning of 2024; therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the Associated Students of Michigan State University shall advocate to appropriate university officials to raise the minimum wage for ULA positions, to \$15 per hour, and to continually adjust this rate according to inflation and government dicta.


