A BILL TO: Add Drink Spiking Prevention Sticker Attachments for Cups to the MSU Union Health and Wellness Vending Machine using ASMSU funds

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

- WHEREAS, Drink spiking, an act of putting drugs in a victim's beverage, is a crime that is linked to illegal activities such as sexual assault and robbery; and,
- WHEREAS, Approximately 6% of American university students have reported having their drink spiked, with drink spiking more prevalent in universities with a "party culture," exhibiting higher binge drinking rates and Greek life (fraternities and sororities) activities¹; and,
- WHEREAS, Michigan State University (MSU) and the city of East Lansing hosts a notable and significant "party culture" on and off campus, whose events can potentially display drink spiking; and,
- WHEREAS, Products as purchased on the internet, such as the StopTopp, exist to provide an easy, ultra-portable, and accessible way for people to protect themselves from drink spiking²; and,
- WHEREAS, MSU administration has frequently shown inaction when it comes to paying for relatively inexpensive products that would significantly contribute to university health and wellness, necessitating the Associated Students of Michigan State University (ASMSU) to take meaningful action for the sake of MSU health and wellness; therefore be it,
