A BILL TO: Call on ASMSU to Advocate for MSU to Replace the Current Menstrual Products with Higher Quality Ones, to be Installed on Every Floor of Buildings that Currently have Menstrual Products

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

- **WHEREAS**, Access to high-quality menstrual hygiene products is essential for student health, dignity, and academic success; and
- **WHEREAS,** The current availability and quality of menstrual products on campus are inconsistent, leaving many students without reliable access to necessary supplies; and
- **WHEREAS**, Inadequate menstrual hygiene can negatively impact students' well-being, attendance, and participation in academic and extracurricular activities; and
- WHEREAS, Ensuring the availability of higher quality menstrual products in every floor and in all campus buildings that currently have them promotes equity and inclusivity, benefitting all students regardless of financial situation; therefore be it,
- **RESOLVED,** ASMSU shall advocate for the installation of higher quality menstrual hygiene dispensers in all restrooms across buildings that currently stock them, ensuring access on every building floor; and let it be further,
- **RESOLVED,** ASMSU shall urge Michigan State University to allocate funding for higher quality menstrual products that meet health and safety standards; and let it be further,
- **RESOLVED,** ASMSU will work with campus administrators to ensure the successful implementation and maintenance of this initiative; and let it be further,

RESOLVED, ASMSU shall call upon Michigan State University to recognize menstrual hygiene as a basic necessity and take immediate action to support students through equitable access to these essential products.
