A BILL TO: Amend the ASMSU General Assembly Code of Operations to Change the Role of Class Council GA Liaisons

THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

WHEREAS, In Fall 2024, the Referendum to Add a General Assembly Seat for each ASMSU Class Council passed¹, which requires ASMSU to amend its governing documents to add four General Assembly seats for each of ASMSU's Class Councils; and,

WHEREAS, Each Class Council elects a General Assembly Liaison as part of the Executive Board, whose role is to attend General Assembly meetings and relay relevant information back to their respective Class Council without wielding any voting power; and,

WHEREAS, Grade level-based representation is an crucial step in expanding the reach of the ASMSU General Assembly and addressing concerns the student body feel are most important; therefore be it;

RESOLVED, The Associated Students of Michigan State University shall amend Title Five: Class Councils of the General Assembly Code of Operations as follows:

(FROM)

Section 6. The delegated General Assembly Liaison for each Class Council will serve as *ex-officio* members of the General Assembly.

(TO)

Section 6. **Each Class Council shall elect a General Assembly Representative to be delegated as the ASMSU GA Representative for that class standing.**


