## A BILL TO: Advocate for the Development of Additional Parking Space Following the Potential Demolition of IM West

## THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACT:

- **WHEREAS**, The IM West building at Michigan State University is currently awaiting a vote for potential demolition<sup>1</sup>, creating an opportunity for the university to address the pressing need for additional parking spaces on campus; and,
- WHEREAS, Parking availability has been consistently identified as a significant concern among many students, impacting their ability to access classes and campus resources effectively<sup>2</sup>; and
- WHEREAS, Research from universities with similar issues indicates that a lack of adequate parking contributes to increased student stress and increased student frustration with the university<sup>3</sup>, highlighting the importance of addressing this issue; and,
- WHEREAS, Converting the IM West building into a parking facility would alleviate congestion and provide much-needed relief to students struggling to find parking on campus; and,
- WHEREAS, Effective parking management in higher education is essential for creating an environment that positively impacts the overall student experience. By providing additional accessible and well-organized parking, we can help students feel more at ease and focused on their academic pursuits; therefore be it,

- **RESOLVED**, That a comprehensive feasibility study be conducted to assess the potential environmental impacts, design considerations, and cost-effectiveness of converting the IM West building into parking space for students.
